What is an endowment?

An endowment is a pool of funds that are permanently set aside and invested to generate an annual and dependable source of support. They can be used for specific donor designated purposes or to support annual funding priorities.

Expenditures are then made from the earnings while the principal remains intact. The funds are generally held in perpetuity, supporting and sustaining the hospital for generations to come.

Endowments can be set up using gifts of stock, cash or life insurance. Funds can be established immediately or you can plan for a future endowment through a bequest in your Will.

You can contribute any amount to an existing fund, or set up your own named fund with a minimum contribution of \$100,000.
